### URGENT REMINDERS TO CIMCIM COLLEAGUES

### 1. CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

As Chairman of the CIMCIM nominating committee, Jeannine Lambrechts-Douillez renews her request for nominations for the following CIMCIM officers:

Officers: President, Vice President\*, Secretary/ Treasurer

\* currently Editor, but proposed in new by-laws as Vice President

Board: three members

She has been requested to submit the slate to the current officers by May 1st.

According to both old and new by-laws, the term limit as officer or as members of the board is six consecutive years (ICOM Statutes 17.4). The new by-laws also state that no more than two members from one country can be selected to the Board (Model Rules for International Committees 7b).

Given these guidelines, the current President and Secretary/Treasurer could serve (and are willing to serve) for another term. Board members Sumi Gunji and Birgit Kjellström will retire after having ably served six years on the Board. Carlos Rausa, on the board only three years, could be renominated for a second term. Hélène La Rue has served as Editor for nine years. Members who have previously served as officers and board members are eligible to be nominated.

ICOM has urged all international committees to seek as wide a geographical representation as possible. When submitting nominations, please consider members who would represent geographic distribution, members who have worked actively on CIMCIM projects, and members who could serve as CIMCIM officers in the future.
